

# SWEETWATER ATV PARK RULES



## HELMET REQUIREMENTS

Georgia Law Requires that any child or youth age 16 years or under is required to wear a D.O.T. approved offroad helmet when riding an ATV.

**Any one entering the park must sign a Release and Waiver of Liability. Must present I.D. Anyone under 18 must have a release form signed by a parent or legal guardian to be able to ride (strictly enforced).**

All riders and guests will be issued an armband. Failure to wear armband could result in removal from the park.

Park Hours: Gate open Friday at 9:00 a.m. until Sunday at 5:00 p.m.

For those arriving on Saturday or Sunday, gate will open at 8:30 a.m.

## Rules

- All riders under 18 must wear a helmet at all times
- Only ATVs/UTVs allowed on dunes and in swamps
- All riders should follow the manufacturer's safety/operating procedures for their ATV
- No ATVs allowed on paved road or horse track-this will result in removal from the park
- No three wheelers allowed on the premises
- 5mph is the speed limit in parking and camping areas
- No trespassing on adjacent properties
- No riding after dark or before daylight
- Anyone riding while intoxicated or under the influence will be suspended
- Flags are required for all children or smaller ATV's but are recommended for everyone
- No hunting
- No firearms
- No drugs
- No glass bottles/containers
- Primitive camping is allowed
- Must clean your parking/camp site. All trash must be placed in cans or dumpsters. Anyone seen putting trash on property will be asked to leave.
- Small campfires are allowed in the primitive camping areas only-firewood not provided
- Do not cut, remove, or destroy trees, shrubs, or other plants
- No fighting-violation of this rule will result in being banned from the property or being arrested
